A Summary of Recent Actions Taken by the Bloomingdale Village Board of Trustees

**VILLAGE BOARD MEETING
MONDAY – September 14, 2020**

Crawford, Murphy & Tilly (CMT) of Aurora, IL was approved to complete the Risk and Resilience Assessment in the amount of \$18,500.00.

The purchase of body camera systems from Watch Guard Video to equip forty-nine (49) Bloomingdale Police Officers in the total amount of \$93,265.00 was approved.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 85-36 AND ORDINANCE 93-52, GRANTING THE APPROVAL OF A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO EXPAND THE EXISTING NURSERY, A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO EXPAND THE EXISTING PLANNED DEVELOPMENT, WITH EXCEPTIONS, APPROVAL OF FINAL SITE PLAN AND FINAL SUBDIVISION FOR THE PROPERTY AT 200-206 W. LAKE STREET; (PLAT HILL NURSERY) was approved.

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE STRATFORD SQUARE MALL TAX INCREMENT FINANCE DISTRICT TO REMOVE CERTAIN PARCELS FROM THE PROJECT AREA was approved.

A RESOLUTION VACATING EXISTING EASEMENTS AND ACCEPTING GRANT OF EASEMENT FOR CERTAIN PUBLIC UTILITIES OVER PORTIONS OF LOT 1 IN BLOOMINGDALE WALK CONDOMINIUM COLLECTION SUBDIVISION FROM THE OWNERS OF CERTAIN PRIVATE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 280-294 STONINGTON DRIVE IN THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE, ILLINOIS was adopted.

Warrant #1 for the Month of September, 2020 in the amount of **\$3,312,352.40** was approved.
