A Summary of Recent Actions Taken by the Bloomingtondale Village Board of Trustees

REGULAR BOARD MEETING – MONDAY – OCTOBER 8, 2007

MAYOR IDEN PROCLAIMED OCTOBER 16, 2007 AS CHARACTER COUNTS! DAY.

THE BLOOMINGDALE GOLF CLUB 2008 golf rates were approved.

WARRANT #1 FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER, 2007 in the amount of \$1,132,405.00 was approved as presented.

TEMPLE OF PRAISE WORSHIP CENTER presented a request for approval of a final site plan and a special use permit for the establishment and operation of a church at the property located at 286 S. Glen Ellyn Road. The Board authorized the preparation of an ordinance.

THE OLD SCHOOL REHABILITATION PROJECT, Change Order No. 2, Superior Painting Inc., total additional amount of \$2,900.00 was ratified.

THE 2007/2008 ROCK SALT purchase was approved and the contract was awarded to North American Salt Company of Overland Park, KS, on the basis of the lowest and best State bid price of \$40.15 per ton.
