A Summary of Recent Actions Taken by the Bloomingdale Village Board of Trustees

REGULAR BOARD MEETING – MONDAY – APRIL 27, 2009

MAYOR IDEN PROCLAIMED THE VILLAGE'S APPRECIATION TO VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR, DANIEL C. WENNERHOLM, for his outstanding contributions and dedication as he celebrates his thirtieth employment anniversary on April 30, 2009.

MAYOR IDEN PROCLAIMED MAY 16, 2009 AS THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE'S RIVER SWEEP 2009 DAY. Residents are encouraged to learn about the environmental importance of clean waterways and participate in the county-wide stream cleanup during American Rivers Month.

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A REZONING, SPECIAL USE PERMIT, APPROVAL OF A PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT WITH EXCEPTIONS AND FINAL SITE PLAN APPROVAL TO ALLOW THE REDEVELOPMENT OF A GAS STATION (296 South Gary Avenue was approved.

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE IDENTITY THEFT PREVENTION PROGRAM was adopted.

A RESOLUTION URGING PASSAGE OF A COMPREHENSIVE CAPITAL INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAM was adopted.

THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE INTERNATIONAL UNION OF OPERATING ENGINEERS, LOCAL 150, Public Employees Division and Village of Bloomingdale effective May 1, 2008 through April 30, 2011 was ratified.

WARRANT #2 FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL, 2009 in the amount of \$1,104,435.33 was approved as presented.

A PET RESCUE update was presented to the Corporate Authorities.

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PLANNING, ZONING & ENVIRONMENTAL CONCERNS

FIVE GUYS BURGER'S & FRIES presented their proposal for a special use permit for an outdoor patio dining area with a maximum seating capacity of twenty (20) persons in conjunction with the operation of a restaurant and an exception to the Village sign ordinance to permit sign copy on patio umbrellas at said restaurant to be located at 383 West Army Trail Road. The Board authorized the preparation of an ordinance.

QDOBA MEXICAN GRILL presented their proposal for a special use permit to allow the sale of alcoholic beverages in conjunction with the operation of a restaurant; an outdoor patio dining area with a maximum seating capacity of fourteen (14) persons; and an exception to the Village sign ordinance to permit sign copy on patio umbrellas at said restaurant to be located at 383 West Army Trail Road. The Board authorized the preparation of an ordinance.
