A Summary of Recent Actions Taken by the Bloomingdale Village Board of Trustees

REGULAR BOARD MEETING – MONDAY – JUNE 22, 2009

MAYOR IDEN PROCLAIMED JUNE 23 AS OLYMPIC DAY in the Village of Bloomingdale in support of Chicago's bid to host the 2016 Olympic and Paralympic Games.

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING AN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE 94-12, A SPECIAL USE PERMIT AND AN ASSOCIATED APPROVAL RELEVANT TO A SHARED PARKING LIMITATION PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE 94-12 (78 Stratford Drive) was approved.

WARRANT #2 FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE, 2009 in the amount of \$2,144,246.31 was approved as presented.

THE WATER RECLAMATION ANNUAL NPDES OPERATING PERMIT FEES in the total amount of \$16,536.17 to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency were approved for payment.

THE EXPENDITURE AND TRANSFER of \$11,990.37 from the Water & Sewer Fund to the General Fund for the purchase of Vehicle #543, a 2005 Chevrolet Impala sedan, was approved effective April 30, 2009.

A PET RESCUE update was presented to the Corporate Authorities.
