A Summary of Recent Actions Taken by the Bloomingdale Village Board of Trustees

REGULAR BOARD MEETING – WEDNESDAY – MAY 27, 2009

MAYOR IDEN REAPPOINTED DAN HAUSER and GUY SANALITRO to the Plan Commission and Zoning Board of Appeals for a term to expire on May 1, 2012.

A REPRESENTATIVE OF PACE PRESENTED A SUBSIDY CHECK to the Village. The subsidy check is to be used for the Village's Dial-A-Ride Program.

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING CERTAIN SPECIAL USE PERMITS, AN EXCEPTION FROM THE BLOOMINGDALE ZONING ORDINANCE, AS AMENDED, AND FINAL SITE PLAN APPROVAL FOR A RESTAURANT USE (109 Franklin Street) was approved.

A RESOLUTION FOR IMPROVEMENT BY MUNICIPALITY UNDER THE ILLINOIS HIGHWAY CODE was adopted.

WARRANT #2 FOR THE MONTH OF MAY, 2009 in the amount of \$1,094,556.90 was approved as presented.

THE FY 2009/10 BUDGET was approved.

THE VILLAGE SERVICES DEPARTMENT, PUBLIC WORKS DIVISION, was authorized to utilize the spot market+procurement procedure to purchase gasoline and diesel fuels for FYE 10 in the total not-to-exceed budget amount of \$214,350.00.

WELL HOUSE #6 BUILDING AT 264 EDGEWATER DRIVE was authorized to be reconstructed at a cost not-to-exceed \$22,000.00. Further, any and all existing lease agreements were terminated.

A PET RESCUE update was presented to the Corporate Authorities.
