**A Summary of Recent Actions Taken by the
Bloomingdale Village Board of Trustees**

**VILLAGE BOARD MEETING
MONDAY – AUGUST 9, 2010**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, TO BORROW FUNDS FROM THE PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY LOAN PROGRAM FOR THE DISTRIBUTION WATERMAIN IMPROVEMENTS – CARDINAL/ORIOLE AREA was approved.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, TO BORROW FUNDS FROM THE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL LOAN PROGRAM FOR THE WATER RECLAMATION FACILITY PHASE 2A IMPROVEMENTS was approved.

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CERTAIN ORDINANCES AND GRANTING FINAL SITE PLAN APPROVAL, SPECIAL USE PERMITS TO ALLOW THE SALE AND DISPENSATION OF ALCOHOL AND LIMITED OUTDOOR SEATING IN CONNECTION THEREWITH AND CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS REGARDING SIGNAGE, LIGHTING, TREE PRESERVATION, LOADING AND SIDEWALK INSTALLATION (SCOTTISH RITE) was approved.

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DESIGNATION OF BUTTERFIELD DR., CARDINAL DR., EDGEWATER DR., FAIRFIELD WAY, RIDGE AVE., COVINGTON DR., MADSEN DR., BRIGHTON RD., AND BYRON AVE. IN THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE AS FEDERAL AID URBAN ROUTES was adopted.

A RESOLUTION INITIATING THE SUBMISSION OF A PUBLIC QUESTION TO SUPPORT REGIONAL ACTIONS TO ATTAIN LONG-TERM PENSION SUSTAINABILITY was adopted.

WARRANT #1 FOR THE MONTH OF AUGUST, 2010 in the amount of \$1,204,232.32 was approved as presented.
