**A Summary of Recent Actions Taken by the
Bloomingdale Village Board of Trustees**

**VILLAGE BOARD MEETING
MONDAY – JANUARY 11, 2010**

MAYOR IDEN SWORE IN JEFF DOLCE to the office of Village Trustee. Trustee Dolce is filling the unexpired term of John Dabrowski. His appointment will be valid until the next election, which is April, 2011.

MAYOR IDEN APPOINTED LEN JASTER to the Plan Commission and Zoning Board of Appeals for a term to expire on May 1, 2010.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13 OF THE BLOOMINGDALE COMPREHENSIVE CODE TO PROVIDE FOR LIQUOR CONTROL (LEGENDS SPORTS GRILLE, INC.) was approved. The ordinance grants Legends Sports Grille, Inc. a Class ~~%D~~-2+liquor license for their restaurant at 170 East Lake Street.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE #96-09 AND GRANTING A SPECIAL USE PERMIT AND AN EXCEPTION FROM THE ZONING ORDINANCE TO ALLOW THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF A VOLUNTARY BLOOD DONATION CENTER (200-204 SOUTH GARY AVENUE) was approved.

WARRANT #1 FOR THE MONTH OF JANUARY, 2010 in the amount of \$1,337,574.34 was approved as presented.

A PET RESCUE update was presented to the Corporate Authorities.

GOLF PLUS INC. was awarded a bonus in the amount of \$24,000 for their excellent performance in running the golf course in calendar year 2009.

CONTRACTS, BIDS, & PURCHASES

KRAMER TREE SPECIALISTS, INC. of West Chicago, IL was awarded a three-year contract extension for the Residential Curbside Branch Collection Program in the amount of \$48,600.00. (\$16,200.00 per pick-up.) Competitive bids were waived.

MAKERS MAINTENANCE ENTERPRISES CO. contract for the Multi-Year Landscape Maintenance Program was not renewed. Makers Maintenance Enterprises Co. is prohibited from bidding on Village landscape maintenance projects for a period of one (1) year.

TASSOS SPYRATOS reimbursement for the work/expense for the %public+ sanitary sewer project for Tassos Restaurant in the amount of \$17,074.00 was approved. The Mayor was authorized to sign and the Clerk to attest to the %Bill of Sale+ transferring ownership of the %public+portion of the sanitary sewer to the Village of Bloomingdale.
