**A Summary of Recent Actions Taken by the
Bloomingdale Village Board of Trustees**

**VILLAGE BOARD MEETING
MONDAY – JUNE 28, 2010**

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING AN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCES 86-4 AND 90-25, EXCEPTIONS FROM THE BLOOMINGDALE ZONING ORDINANCE, AS AMENDED, AND FINAL SITE PLAN APPROVALS (Lots 11 and 15, Bloomingdale Court Shopping Center – Walmart) was approved.

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR A FREEZE IN COMPENSATION FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING APRIL 30, 2011 was adopted.

WARRANT #2 FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE, 2010 in the amount of \$1,489,732.75 was approved as presented.

THE WATER RECLAMATION ANNUAL NPDES OPERATING PERMIT FEES in the total amount of \$19,000.00 to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency were approved for payment.

THE EXPENDITURE AND TRANSFER of \$7,193.42 from the Water & Sewer Fund to the General Fund for the "purchase" of Vehicle #542, a 2005 Chevrolet Impala sedan, was approved effective April 30, 2010.

THE 5-YEAR FORECASTS FOR THE WATER & SEWER FUND AND GOLF COURSE OPERATIONS FUND were received by the Board.

THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE AND THE FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE LABOR COUNCIL FOR LODGE #175 for the Full-Time Sworn Officers Bargaining Unit providing for a one-year wage freeze and extending the contract term from August 31, 2011 to August 31, 2012 was approved. The Mayor was authorized to sign and the Clerk to attest to said agreement.
