**A Summary of Recent Actions Taken by the
Bloomingdale Village Board of Trustees**

**VILLAGE BOARD MEETING
MONDAY – APRIL 11, 2011**

MAYOR IDEN ANNOUNCED THAT GARY SZOTT, FINANCE DIRECTOR, DAVID MEIMERS, ASSISTANT FINANCE DIRECTOR AND JUNE FERGUS, ACCOUNTANT, WERE AWARDED THE CERTIFICATE OF ACHIEVEMENT FOR EXCELLENCE IN FINANCIAL REPORTING. A Certificate of Achievement is presented to those government units whose annual financial reports are judged to adhere to program standards and represents the highest award in government financial reporting.

MAYOR IDEN INVITED THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES TO THE DUPAGE MAYORS & MANAGERS CONFERENCE'S MONTHLY DINNER MEETING to be held on Wednesday, April 20, 2011, at the Embassy Suites Hotel, 707 E. Butterfield Road, Lombard.

AN ORDINANCE RESERVING VOLUME CAP IN CONNECTION WITH PRIVATE ACTIVITY BOND ISSUES AND RELATED MATTERS was passed.

WARRANT #1 FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL, 2011 in the amount of \$870,239.29 was approved as presented.

BALLYDOYLE BLOOMINGDALE, d/b/a Ballydoyle Restaurant, presented their proposal for final site plan approval, as required by Ordinance No. 2009-45, to allow the expansion of an existing seating area and other improvements adjacent to their Ballydoyle Restaurant located at 152 Stratford Square. The Board authorized the preparation of an ordinance.

SYNAGRO of 7014 E. Baltimore Street, Baltimore, MD was awarded the contract for the Water Reclamation Facility Biosolids Removal Program for FY 12 – FY 16 in the amounts of \$20.75 per cubic feet of dry land application, \$0.04 per mobile dewatering, and \$0.05 per gallon of liquid land application.

PRELIMINARY REVIEW OF FY 12 OPERATING & CAPITAL BUDGET PROPOSAL was distributed and reviewed.
