A Summary of Recent Actions Taken by the Bloomingdale Village Board of Trustees

**VILLAGE BOARD MEETING
MONDAY – JULY 25, 2011**

A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING AND EXPRESSING APPRECIATION FOR THE SERVICE OF SUSAN L. BARTUCCI, VILLAGE CLERK, FROM JANUARY 2001 TO JULY 2011 was adopted. Ms. Bartucci resigned as Village Clerk effective July 31, 2011.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13 OF THE BLOOMINGDALE COMPREHENSIVE CODE TO PROVIDE FOR LIQUOR CONTROL, SECTION 13-1-10 (NUMBER OF LICENSES) TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF CLASS "P" LICENSES (GOLD STANDARD ENTERPRISES, INC., D/B/A BINNY'S BEVERAGE DEPOT) was passed. Binny's Beverage Depot will be located at 353 West Army Trail Road.

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE INTERNATIONAL BUILDING CODE (2009 EDITION), WITH LOCAL AMENDMENTS, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2005-10 (AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE INTERNATIONAL BUILDING CODE (2003 EDITION), WITH LOCAL AMENDMENTS) was passed.

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2008-18 AND ORDINANCE 2009-28, GRANTING FINAL SITE PLAN APPROVAL, AN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 85-27 AND ORDINANCE NO. 86-21 AND AN EXCEPTION FROM THE BLOOMINGDALE ZONING ORDINANCE, AS AMENDED, TO ALLOW CERTAIN SITE RENOVATIONS AND A FREE-STANDING SIGN WITH LED PRICING NUMERALS (THORNTONS - 190 EAST LAKE STREET) was passed.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RELEASE OF EXECUTIVE SESSION MEETING MINUTES was adopted.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DESTRUCTION OF AUDIO RECORDINGS OF CLOSE MEETING SESSIONS was adopted.

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE AND THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION CONCERNING SHARED RESPONSIBILITY FOR ENERGY AND MAINTENANCE COSTS OF LOCAL TRAFFIC SIGNALS (TRAFFIC SIGNAL MAINTENANCE MASTER AGREEMENT) was adopted.

WARRANT #2 FOR THE MONTH OF JULY, 2011 in the amount of \$1,476,908.64 was approved as presented.

PLANNING, ZONING & ENVIRONMENTAL CONCERNS

PETCO ANIMAL SUPPLIES, INC. presented their proposal for approval of a text amendment to add a land use category of “pet adoption service accessory to a pet shop” as an allowed special use category within the B-2 Community Business District and a special use permit for a “pet adoption service accessory to a pet shop.” An animal adoption center is proposed to be located on a portion of their premises at 412 West Army Trail Road. The Board authorized the preparation of an ordinance.

TOYS “R” US presented their proposal for approval of an exception to the Sign Ordinance to allow for a wall-mounted sign per Ordinance No. 2002-16; new signage in the parking lot area; improvements to the front entry area in the Toys “R” Us portion of the shopping center and landscaping improvements throughout the overall parking area located at 404 West Army Trail Road. The Board authorized the preparation of an ordinance.
