**A Summary of Recent Actions Taken by the
Bloomingdale Village Board of Trustees**

**VILLAGE BOARD MEETING
MONDAY – JUNE 27, 2011**

AN ORDINANCE MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR CORPORATE PURPOSES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR MAY 1, 2011 TO APRIL 30, 2012 was approved. Prior to adoption, a public hearing was held in order to receive public input.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS PROPERTY OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE (PUBLIC WORKS EQUIPMENT) was passed.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OR DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE (VEHICLE NO. 195) was passed.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 86-33 TO PROVIDE FOR A FIVE PERCENT (5%) HOTEL USE TAX IN PLACE OF A FIVE PERCENT (5%) HOTEL OCCUPATION TAX ON HOTEL OPERATORS AND EXTENDING SUCH USE TAX TO ALL HOTEL PATRONS AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2007-27 TO EXTEND THE EXISTING ONE PERCENT (1%) HOTEL USE TAX TO CLARIFY THAT IT EXTENDS TO ALL HOTEL PATRONS was passed.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING A CHANGE ORDER INVOLVING AN INCREASE IN THE CONTRACT PRICE OF \$10,000 OR MORE (CARDINAL DRIVE & ORIOLE STREET WATERMAIN IMPROVEMENT – SOD IN LIEU OF SEED RESTORATION) was adopted.

WARRANT #2 FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE, 2011 in the amount of \$1,064,353.10 was approved as presented.

THE AFTER ACTION REPORT/IMPROVEMENT PLAN FOR THE FEBRUARY 2011 BLIZZARD was accepted.

THE VILLAGE'S CONTRIBUTION TO THE 2011 SEPTEMBERFEST EVENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$20,000 was approved.

CHICAGO INTERNATIONAL TRUCKS of Chicago, IL, was awarded the contract for the purchase of a 2011 regular cab two-door truck with aerial lift and fiberglass service body in the net amount of \$185,912, including a trade-in of Village Vehicle No. 195 in the amount of \$9,900.

VIAN CONSTRUCTION, INC., Change Order No. 3, Cardinal Drive and Oriole Street Water Main Improvements, Supplemental Waterings, Addition of \$1,595 per watering.
