**A Summary of Recent Actions Taken by the
Bloomingdale Village Board of Trustees**

VILLAGE BOARD MEETING

MONDAY – NOVEMBER 26, 2012

MAYOR IDEN WAS RECOGNIZED FOR HIS TWENTY (20) YEARS OF EXEMPLARY SERVICE AND COMMITMENT TO THE CITIZENS OF THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE. The Board presented him with a plaque and expressed their gratitude to the Mayor.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BLOOMINGDALE VILLAGE CODE, AS AMENDED, TITLE 9 (WATER AND SEWER); CHAPTER 1 (GENERAL WATER AND SEWER REGULATIONS; RATES AND CHARGES); SECTION 3 (CONNECTION FEES) was approved.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BLOOMINGDALE VILLAGE CODE, AS AMENDED, TITLE 9 (WATER AND SEWER); CHAPTER 2 (WATER USE AND SERVICE) TO ADD A NEW SECTION 5 (PRIVATE WATER WELLS) was approved.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BLOOMINGDALE VILLAGE CODE, AS AMENDED, TITLE 2 (BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND COMMITTEES); TO REPEAL AND REPLACE CHAPTER 4 (BUSINESS PROMOTION AND CULTURAL DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE); WITH A NEW CHAPTER 4 (BUSINESS PROMOTION COMMITTEE) was approved.

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING GOVERNMENTAL SELF-INSURANCE POOLING AND IN OPPOSITION TO NON-PRODUCTIVE LEGISLATIVE RESTRAINTS was adopted.

THE FILING DATES OF PETITIONS FOR THE APRIL 9, 2013 CONSOLIDATED ELECTION were announced. Petitions circulated for Independent, New Party and Non-Municipal Nonpartisan office candidates will be accepted beginning on December 17 through December 24, 2012 from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. except the last day of filing when the office will remain open until 5:00 p.m.

THE 2012 SEPTEMBERFEST FINANCIAL REPORT DATED NOVEMBER 15, 2012 was accepted as presented.

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FINANCE & ADMINISTRATION

THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING APRIL 30, 2012 COMPREHENSIVE FINANCIAL REPORT FROM WOLF AND COMPANY, LLP was accepted as presented.

THE 2ND QUARTERLY FISCAL YEAR TREASURER'S REPORT was accepted as presented.

WARRANT #1 FOR THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER, 2012 in the amount of \$730,678.49 was approved as presented.
