### **A Summary of Recent Actions Taken by the Bloomingdale Village Board of Trustees**

**VILLAGE BOARD MEETING  
MONDAY – OCTOBER 14, 2013**

**MAYOR COLADIPIETRO PROCLAIMED OCTOBER 15, 2013 AS CHARACTER COUNTS! DAY IN THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE.**

**MAYOR COLADIPIETRO APPOINTED DAVID W. SMITH** to the Plan Commission for a term to expire October 1, 2016 and to the Zoning Board of Appeals for a term to expire October 1, 2018.

**MAYOR COLADIPIETRO APPOINTED SEBASTIAN (BUZZ) PUCCIO**, President of the Bloomingdale Park District Board of Commissioners to the Ad Hoc Committee for the Indian Lakes Area Open Space Planning Study as a member for a term to expire August 31, 2014.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BLOOMINGDALE VILLAGE CODE, AS AMENDED, TITLE 4 (BUSINESS AND LICENSE REGULATIONS); CHAPTER 2 (ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES); SECTION 29 (INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM FOR PERSONNEL; ATTENDANCE REQUIRED)** was passed.

**A PUBLIC HEARING BEFORE THE VILLAGE BOARD TO CONSIDER A PLAT OF VACATION FOR A CERTAIN SECTION OF THE SOUTH PRAIRIE AVENUE RIGHT-OF-WAY, BETWEEN THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF 164 SOUTH PRAIRIE AVENUE AND ITS SOUTH TERMINUS** was approved to be advertised and scheduled.

**CONSIDERATION OF THE VACATION OF DEDICATED SIDEWALK ACCESS PROPERTY LOCATED BETWEEN 213 & 215 FREEPORT DRIVE** was approved. Staff was directed to research the necessary steps and report to the Village Board.

**THE VILLAGE'S PETITION FOR AN AMENDMENT TO TITLE 11** (Zoning Regulations, Chapters 4, 5, 8, 11, 13, 14, 18, and 20) of the Village Code, as amended, and as outlined in the Findings of Fact and Recommendation from the Plan Commission dated October 8, 2013 was reviewed. The Board authorized the preparation of an ordinance.

**ST. AUBIN NURSERY**, 35445 Irene Road, Kirkland, Illinois was awarded the FY 14 Tree Planting Program (Fall of 2013) in the amount of \$46,288.00.

**WARRANT #1 FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER, 2013** in the amount of \$1,139,353.15 was approved as presented.
