**A Summary of Recent Actions Taken by the  
Bloomingdale Village Board of Trustees**

**VILLAGE BOARD MEETING  
MONDAY – OCTOBER 13, 2014**

**MAYOR COLADIPIETRO SWORE IN BRUCE MASON AS A SERGEANT OF POLICE.**  
He was promoted to the rank of Sergeant effective October 5, 2014.

**MAYOR COLADIPIETRO PROCLAIMED OCTOBER 14, 2014 AS CHARACTER  
COUNTS! DAY IN THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE.**

**A PUBLIC HEARING ON A PETITION FOR ANNEXATION** for the property located at the intersection of Lawrence Avenue and Springfield Drive, a/k/a/ 24W411 and 24W435 Lawrence Avenue in Unincorporated DuPage County was held.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11 (ZONING REGULATIONS) – CHAPTER 2 (RULES AND DEFINITIONS) - SECTION 2 (DEFINITIONS) “KENNEL” OF THE VILLAGE CODE (NUMBER OF DOMESTIC ANIMALS)** was passed.

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN INTERFUND LOAN FROM THE HOME RULE SALES TAX FUND TO THE GOLF COURSE FUND** was adopted.

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING INTERVENTION IN REAL PROPERTY TAX ASSESSMENT APPEALS** was adopted.

**WARRANT #1 FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER, 2014** in the amount of \$1,139,973.52 was approved as presented.

**PACKAGED INCIDENTAL LIQUOR SALES** for convenience stores and gas stations were discussed.

**WOOLPERT, INC. ON BEHALF OF CHICK-FIL-A** presented their request for approval of the repeal of Ordinance No. 92-15; a special use permit to allow a drive-through; exceptions to the Village Code and other ordinances for front building setback, wall mounted signs, and building materials; and a final site plan to allow the construction of a Chick-fil-A Restaurant at 354 West Army Trail Road. The Board authorized the preparation of an ordinance.

**THE EMERALD ASH BORER (EAB) RESPONSE PLAN IMPLEMENTATION STATUS** was presented and discussed.

**CONTRACTS, BIDS, & PURCHASES**

**GLENBROOK EXCAVATING AND CONCRETE, INC.** of Wauconda, Illinois, upon the waiver of the advertising of bids, was awarded the contract to replace the trench drain at the northeast corner of the Village Hall parking lot in the not-to-exceed amount of \$25,000.

**ST. AUBIN NURSERY & LANDSCAPING** of Kirkland, Illinois, the lowest responsible bidder, was awarded the contract for the FY15 Fall (2014) Tree Planting Program in the amount of \$70,800.00.
