**VILLAGE BOARD MEETING
MONDAY – NOVEMBER 24, 2014**

MAYOR COLADIPIETRO SWORE IN POLICE DOG, KANE, TO THE K9 UNIT AND PRESENTED KANE WITH BADGE #201. Officer McGhee will be training and working with Kane in his law enforcement duties.

THE 2ND QUARTER OF THE FISCAL YEAR 15 VILLAGE TREASURER'S REPORT FOR THE PERIOD OF MAY 1, 2014 THROUGH OCTOBER 31, 2014 was accepted.

WARRANT #2 FOR THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER, 2014 in the amount of \$1,599,587.56 was approved as presented.

INDIAN LAKES OPEN SPACE DRAINAGE PROJECT was discussed.

CURRIE MOTORS of Frankfort, Illinois, through the Suburban Purchasing Co-Op Contract, was awarded the contract for the purchase of three (3) Ford Utility (SUV-AWD) Interceptors and two (2) Chevy Tahoe's in the amount of \$151,237.56 and an additional amount of \$26,050.00 for licenses, titles, striping and changeover costs for the five (5) vehicles, for a total amount of \$177,287.56.

PIPE VIEW, LLC of Bartlett, Illinois was awarded the contract for the FY 2015 Annual Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) Inspection of Sanitary and Storm Sewers in the amount of \$81,524.00.
