**VILLAGE BOARD MEETING
MONDAY – FEBRUARY 9, 2015**

MAYOR COLADIPIETRO SWORE IN JOSEPH BATTAGLIA, MICHAEL GIOVENCO AND YELENA MALINOVSKAYA AS PROBATIONARY POLICE OFFICERS. The officers are presently attending the Suburban Law Enforcement Academy.

MAYOR COLADIPIETRO REAPPOINTED LOUIS PAVONE to the Board of Fire and Police Commission for a term to expire on May 1, 2017.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF \$3,420,000.00 GENERAL OBLIGATION REFUNDING BONDS, SERIES 2015, OF THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AND PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF A DIRECT ANNUAL TAX SUFFICIENT FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON SUCH BONDS was passed.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RELEASE OF EXECUTIVE SESSION MEETING MINUTES was adopted.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DESTRUCTION OF AUDIO RECORDINGS OF CLOSED MEETING SESSIONS was adopted.

WARRANT #1 FOR THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY, 2015 in the amount of \$958,314.74 was approved as presented.

AIROOM, INC. on behalf of Trinidad Vega, property owner, presented their proposal for approval of a variation to the minimum Floor Area Ratio (F.A.R.) requirement of 0.30 to a new F.A.R. of 0.36 to allow the construction of a family and dining room addition to the single family residence at 151 North Pleasant Avenue. The Board authorized the preparation of an ordinance.
