**VILLAGE BOARD MEETING**

**MONDAY – JUNE 8, 2015**

**MAYOR COLADIPIETRO APPOINTED TED CUCCI** to the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners to fill Warren Gnau's unexpired term which will expire on May 1, 2016.

**MAYOR COLADIPIETRO APPOINTED JIM KING** to the Planning and Zoning Commission for a term that will expire on May 1, 2018.

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING REZONING OF THE PROPERTY AT 241 E. LAKE STREET FROM B-3, GENERAL SERVICES BUSINESS DISTRICT, TO B-2 COMMUNITY BUSINESS DISTRICT; REPEAL OF ORDINANCE NO. 87-47, WHICH REZONED THE PROPERTY AND GRANTED SPECIAL USE APPROVAL FOR A RECREATION AND ENTERTAINMENT USE AND ORDINANCE NO. 96-34, WHICH AMENDED THE SPECIAL USE AND GRANTED FINAL SITE PLAN APPROVAL FOR AN OUTDOOR PATIO WITH THE SALE/SERVICE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND FOOD SERVICE ON THE PATIO; A SPECIAL USE FOR A MEMORY CARE FACILITY, A USE SIMILAR AND COMPATIBLE TO A NURSING HOME OR GERIATRIC CENTER; A SPECIAL USE FOR A PLANNED DEVELOPMENT, WITH EXCEPTIONS; PRELIMINARY SUBDIVISION AND A FINAL SITE PLAN (237-241 E. LAKE STREET)** was passed.

**GREENBRIER SENIOR LIVING LLC** submitted a request for a reconsideration of the motion relative to a petition submitted by them, that accepted the Plan Commission's Finding of Fact and Recommendations dated April 21, 2015 and moved to deny their petition for an ordinance amendment, special use permits, zoning ordinance exceptions, preliminary site plan and plat of consolidation for the construction of a 94,300 square foot assisted living and memory care facility on the 4.156-acre site with a surface parking lot for 66 vehicles and to remand the matter to the Plan Commission for discussion and review of an amended petition for a preliminary site plan and plat of consolidation for the construction of an assisted living and memory care facility on the properties commonly known as 166-178 West Lake Street. Their request was granted.

**WARRANT #1 FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE, 2015** in the amount of \$896,697.40 was approved as presented.
