**Summary of Recent Actions Taken by the
Bloomingdale Village Board of Trustees**

**VILLAGE BOARD MEETING
MONDAY – AUGUST 22, 2016**

MAYOR COLADIPIETRO PROCLAIMED SEPTEMBER 8, 2016 AS “GO ORANGE DAY” in Bloomingdale, in support of National Hunger Awareness Month. The Mayor encouraged residents and businesses to help raise awareness of hunger in the area by wearing orange on September 8, 2016 and to assist those in need by donating food/supplies and/or volunteering time to Bloomingdale’s local food pantries.

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE SIMPLIFIED MUNICIPAL TELECOMMUNICATIONS TAX RATE FROM 5.00% TO 3.00% FOR THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS was passed.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE INDUCEMENT OF A DEVELOPER FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE PROPERTIES COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS 201 E. LAKE STREET AND 205-215 E. LAKE STREET, BLOOMINGDALE, ILLINOIS 60108 was adopted.

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A LOCAL PUBLIC AGENCY AGREEMENT FOR FEDERAL PARTICIPATION BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE AND THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO COMPLETE CONSTRUCTION OF A SEGMENT OF THE EAST BRANCH DUPAGE RIVER TRAIL ALONG GLEN ELLYN ROAD (FAU 2581) FROM CARRIAGE WAY TO EDGEWATER DRIVE USING FEDERAL SURFACE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM GRANT FUNDING was adopted.

WARRANT #2 FOR THE MONTH OF AUGUST, 2016 in the amount of \$1,393,069.17 was approved as presented.
