## A Summary of Recent Actions Taken by the Bloomington Village Board of Trustees

### REGULAR BOARD MEETING – MONDAY – MARCH 10, 2008

**MAYOR IDEN PROCLAIMED MARCH 11, 2008** as the 175<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Founding of Bloomington.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13 AND EXHIBIT A TO THE BLOOMINGDALE COMPREHENSIVE CODE (Lone Star Steakhouse)** was approved. Lone Star Steakhouse & Saloon located at 304 W. Army Trail Road has closed and no longer requires a liquor license.

**A RESOLUTION ENDORSING AN INITIATIVE TO NEGOTIATE A LEGISLATIVE COMPROMISE TO AVOID POTENTIAL FISCAL STRIFE RESULTING FROM THE PUBLIC SAFETY EMPLOYEE BENEFIT ACT (PSEBA)** was adopted.

**WARRANT #1 FOR THE MONTH OF MARCH, 2008** in the amount of \$2,547,963.79 was approved as presented.

**GMX REAL ESTATE GROUP, LLC** presented their proposal for an amendment to Ordinance 90-64 to permit wall mural signage, planters, three (3) additional wall mounted directory signs and two (2) tenant identification panels at the Stratford Crossings Shopping Center. The Board authorized the preparation of an ordinance.

**IN-SITE REAL ESTATE, LLC** presented their proposal for approval of their preliminary site plan to permit the demolition of the existing former Tower Records building located at 383 Army Trail Road and replace it with two multi-tenant retail buildings for a total of 18,464 square feet and 147 parking spaces. The Board denied their request.

**"THE CORPORATE AUTHORIZATION RESOLUTION"** was approved. The resolution updates the authorized signatures of the Village's depository.

**THE PLAT OF DEDICATION AND EASEMENT FOR ANGELOS' SCHICK ROAD SUBDIVISION** was approved. The Mayor was authorized to sign and the Clerk to attest to the said Plat of Dedication and Easement.

**THE JOINT AGENCY AGREEMENT BETWEEN IDOT** and the Village of Bloomington for reimbursement of construction cost to install concrete curb and gutter on Lake Street between Summerfield Drive and Springfield Drive was approved. The Mayor was authorized to sign and the Clerk to attest to the agreement.

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**CONTRACTS, BIDS, & PURCHASES**

**OCE'** was approved as the vendor for the purchase of one model TCS4XT large format scanner in the amount of \$16,805.00.

**PATTEN INDUSTRIES** of Elmhurst, IL was approved as the vendor for the purchase of a 2008 caterpillar 305 Mini Excavator in the amount of \$73,309.00. The purchase a trailer to transport said mini-excavator in the not-to-exceed amount of \$19,691.00 pursuant to competitive quotes was also approved.

**POWER UP** of Chicago, IL was approved as the vendor for electrical distribution for Family Fest 2008 in the amount of \$17,500.00.
