## **A Summary of Recent Actions Taken by the Bloomingtondale Village Board of Trustees**

### **REGULAR BOARD MEETING – MONDAY – APRIL 9, 2007**

**MAYOR IDEN PRESENTED BUILDING INSPECTOR, TERRY SPRADLING**, with an award for her brave act of heroism.

**MAYOR IDEN SWORE IN CHAD FARRELL AS A PROBATIONARY POLICE OFFICER.** Officer Farrell is presently attending the Suburban Law Enforcement Academy.

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF LAKE STREET (OUTER EASTBOUND AND OUTER WESTBOUND LANES) FROM ROSEDALE AVENUE TO GARDEN AVENUE TO ACCOMMODATE THE FIREWORKS DISPLAY FOR THE 2007 BLOOMINGDALE FAMILY FEST** was adopted.

**THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF DUPAGE AND THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE DATED SEPTEMBER 23, 2003 FOR THE IMPROVEMENTS RELATING TO CONSTRUCTION OF CH 11/ARMY TRAIL ROAD (REGENCY DRIVE TO SWIFT ROAD), SECTION 97-00286-01-WR** was approved. The Village President was authorized to sign and the Village Clerk to attest to said agreement.

**WARRANT #1 FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL, 2007** in the amount of \$825,047.02 was approved as presented.

**THE EXTENSION OF THE TEMPORARY PART-TIME MAINTENANCE WORKER II** position was approved for a period of six (6) months with the option to extend the employment arrangement for an additional six (6) months.

**ABM COMMERCIAL FLOORING, INC.** of Roselle, IL was awarded the contract for the Bloomingtondale Golf Club carpet replacement on the basis of their lowest and best bid of \$22,658.00.

**CASEY EQUIPMENT COMPANY, INC.** of Arlington Heights, IL was awarded the contract for the asphalt conveyor paver on the basis of their bid of \$76,250.00.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE MINIMUM REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE CONDITIONS AND MAINTENANCE OF ALL PROPERTY, BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES; BY PROVIDING THE STANDARDS FOR SUPPLIED UTILITIES AND FACILITIES AND OTHER PHYSICAL THINGS AND CONDITIONS ESSENTIAL TO INSURE THAT STRUCTURES ARE SAFE, SANITARY AND FIT FOR OCCUPATION AND USE; AND THE CONDEMNATION OF BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES UNFIT FOR HUMAN OCCUPANCY AND USE AND THE DEMOLITION OF SUCH STRUCTURES; KNOWN AS THE PROPERTY MAINTENANCE CODE; **ADOPTING THE INTERNATIONAL PROPERTY MAINTENANCE CODE (2006 EDITION)** AND REPEALING OF EXISTING ORDINANCE NO. 2004-13 (INTERNATIONAL PROPERTY MAINTENANCE CODE, 2003 EDITION) was passed.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE MINIMUM REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE DESIGN, INSTALLATION, CONSTRUCTION AND USE OF ELECTRICAL SYSTEMS AND PRACTICAL SAFEGUARDS; **ADOPTING THE NFPA NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE (2005 EDITION)**; AND REPEALING EXISTING ORDINANCE NO. 2004-15 (NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE, 2002 EDITION) was passed.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE MINIMUM REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE DESIGN, INSTALLATION, CONSTRUCTION AND USE OF FUEL GAS SYSTEMS, GAS FIRED APPLIANCES AND PRACTICAL SAFEGUARDS; **ADOPTING THE INTERNATIONAL FUEL GAS CODE (2006 EDITION)**; AND REPEALING EXISTING ORDINANCE NO. 2004-16 (INTERNATIONAL FUEL GAS CODE, 2003 EDITION) was passed.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE MINIMUM REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE DESIGN, INSTALLATION, CONSTRUCTION AND USE OF ENERGY EFFICIENT BUILDING ENVELOPES AND INSTALLATION OF ENERGY EFFICIENT MECHANICAL, LIGHTING AND POWER SYSTEMS; **ADOPTING THE INTERNATIONAL ENERGY CONSERVATION CODE (2006 EDITION)**; AND REPEALING EXISTING ORDINANCE NO. 2004-17 (INTERNATIONAL ENERGY CONSERVATION CODE, 2003 EDITION) was passed.
