A Summary of Recent Actions Taken by the Bloomington Village Board of Trustees

SPECIAL BOARD MEETING – MONDAY – JULY 30, 2007

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE INDIAN LAKES RESORT BUSINESS DISTRICT was approved.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND IMPOSING A TAX OF ONE PERCENT UPON ALL PATRONS OF HOTEL AND MOTELS WHO RENT, LEASE, OR LET ROOMS FROM A HOTEL OR MOTEL WITHIN THE VILLAGE was approved.

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A VARIATION TO PERMIT A REDUCTION IN THE DEPTH OF THE REQUIRED MINIMUM REAR YARD ON THE PROPERTY KNOWN AS 406 MEADOWLARK ROAD IN THE INDIAN LAKES COUNTRY CLUB ESTATES RESIDENTIAL SUBDIVISION (TASOULIS RESIDENCE) was approved.

A TEMPORARY VARIANCE TO THE LIQUOR LICENSE of Rooster's Barn and Grill Restaurant at 122 W. Lake Street was granted to permit the sale of beer and wine at Founder's Park between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. on Friday, August 10, 2007 for the 9th Annual Roy's Famous Friday Night Fish Fry.
