A Summary of Recent Actions Taken by the Bloomington Village Board of Trustees

REGULAR BOARD MEETING – MONDAY – JUNE 11, 2007

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO ALLOW THE EXPANSION OF AN EXISTING PACKAGE LIQUOR STORE TO APPROXIMATELY 2,800 SQUARE FEET AND RELOCATION TO A NEW TENANT SPACE LOCATED AT 274 AND 276 GLEN ELLYN ROAD (PIK N GO) was approved.

THE TREASURER'S REPORT FOR THE PERIOD OF MAY 1, 2006 – APRIL 30, 2007 was approved as presented.

WARRANT #1 FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE, 2007 in the amount of \$1,729,260.24 was approved as presented.

EDWARDS ENGINEERING INC. of Elk Grove Village, IL was approved as the vendor for the HVAC Contract in the total contract cost of \$32,064.00 which represents year five (5) of the five (5) year contract extension.

SAUBER MANUFACTURING COMPANY of Virgil, IL was awarded the contract for the purchase of a Paving Trailer with Hydraulic Ramps for a total cost of \$26,239.00.

SIX VENDORS: KOZ TRUCKING, CRUSH-KRETE, INC., EARTH INC., BLUFF CITY, A LAMP AND DUPAGE TOP SOIL were authorized for hauling and dumping contract work in an expenditure of up to \$35,000.00 during FYE08.
