A Summary of Recent Actions Taken by the Bloomingtondale Village Board of Trustees

REGULAR BOARD MEETING – MONDAY – MAY 24, 2007

JUDGE ANN JORGENSEN SWORE IN THE NEW ELECTED BOARD MEMBERS: TRUSTEES ROBERT CZERNEK, JOHN DABROWSKI, AND JIM KING. The members were elected during the Consolidated Election held on April 17, 2007.

MAYOR IDEN REAPPOINTED WARREN GNAU TO THE BOARD OF FIRE AND POLICE COMMISSIONERS; JEFFREY T. DOLCE AND J. THOMAS BRICE TO THE PLAN COMMISSION AND ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS; and STEVE APOSTOLOPOULOS TO THE POLICE PENSION BOARD.

MAYOR IDEN ANNOUNCED THAT GARY SZOTT, FINANCE DIRECTOR, WAS AWARDED THE CERTIFICATE OF ACHIEVEMENT FOR EXCELLENCE IN FINANCIAL REPORTING. A Certificate of Achievement is presented to those government units whose annual financial reports are judged to adhere to program standards and represents the highest award in government financial reporting.

MAYOR IDEN PROCLAIMED THE MONTH OF JUNE AS AMERICAN RIVERS MONTH IN THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE. Mayor Iden encouraged resident to learn about the environmental importance of clean waterways and to participate in River Sweep 2007 on Saturday, June 2, 2007.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, ASCERTAINING THE PREVAILING RATE OF WAGES FOR LABORERS, WORKMEN AND MECHANICS EMPLOYED ON PUBLIC WORKS OF SAID VILLAGE was approved.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLES IV, VII, VIII, X, X-A, XI, AND XII OF "THE BLOOMINGDALE ZONING ORDINANCE," AS AMENDED, REGARDING MINIMUM SETBACKS AND ACCESSORY STRUCTURES IN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS, OUTDOOR DINING IN BUSINESS DISTRICTS, PLANNED DEVELOPMENT EXCEPTIONS, SPECIAL USES IN THE PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT OF 250 ACRES OR MORE, OFF-STREET PARKING REQUIREMENTS, CERTAIN ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS REGARDING THE DIRECTOR OF BUILDING AND ZONING, FINES, APPLICATION FEES, AND THE AUTHORITY OF THE ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS was approved.

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CHANGE ORDERS

OLD SCHOOL REHABILITATION PROJECT, Change Orders 1 through 5 in the total additional amount of \$46,890.00 were ratified. The total contract amount is \$713,133.00.

CONTRACTS, BIDS, & PURCHASES

DUPAGE MAYORS AND MANAGERS CONFERENCE FY 2007/2008 annual membership dues in the amount of \$18,693.02 were approved for payment.

ENVIRO-TEST/PERRY LABS INC. of Willowbrook, IL was approved as the vendor for lab services for the Water Reclamation Facility in the amount of \$17,751.00.

GOLF PLUS, INC. was awarded a bonus per their contract in the total amount of \$22,500.00 for calendar year 2006.

SYNAGRO, INC. of Sugar Grove, IL was approved as the vendor for bio-solids removal needs for the Water Reclamation Facility in the amount of \$300,000.00 which represents year three (3) of the five (5) year contract extension.

FINANCE AND PERSONNEL

FY 2007/08 BUDGET was approved.

WARRANT #2 FOR THE MONTH OF MAY, 2007 in the amount of \$1,140,172.84 was approved as presented.

PLANNING, ZONING & ENVIRONMENTAL CONCERNS

JAY PURSHOTTAM CORPORATION, doing business as Pik-N-Go Liquor Inc., presented their proposal for the establishment and operation of an approximately 2,800 square foot packaged liquor store at 274 and 276 Glen Ellyn Road on the property located at 270-280 Glen Ellyn Road. The Board authorized the preparation of an ordinance.

THE PLAT OF SUBDIVISION FOR THE BLOOMINGDALE HORIZON SENIOR LIVING COMMUNITY Plat of Resubdivision was approved. The Mayor was authorized to sign and the Clerk to attest to the said Plat of Subdivision
