Village Code Title 9, Section 1, Chapter 6, regulates charges for temporary connections using temporary meters or fire hydrant meters and consumption of water.

The charges for such services are listed below: **EFFECTIVE AS OF JANUARY 1, 2015**

1. **Water used, as registered on the meter, shall be charged at \$8.88 per 1,000 gallons and is due and payable by the applicant. There will be no charge for the day if returned by 10:00 a.m.**
2. **A daily temporary meter/hydrant meter charge of \$10.00 per day of use shall be paid, in addition to payment for water consumption.**
3. At the time the meter is issued, a deposit in the amount of \$150.00 shall be posted by the applicant to secure payment of the daily meter rental fees and water use.
4. **Upon the meter's return, the \$150.00 deposit shall be applied to any daily rental fee and water consumption charges, as applicable along with a \$20.00 non-refundable administrative fee . Any remaining fees shall be invoiced to the applicant, payable upon receipt. Any remaining deposit shall be refunded to the applicant.**
5. **Use of temporary meter/hydrant meter is limited to 30 days. For use beyond 30 days, a new permit is required which is subject to an additional \$150.00 advance payment for each such 30 day period.**
6. If a meter is stolen, lost or damaged, the person, firm or corporation signing this application shall be responsible for replacing the meter at the current market price.
7. The meter must be returned to the Utilities Division at the Public Works Facility, 305 Glen Ellyn Road, Bloomingdale, IL.
